**Specific duties include but are not limited to:**

- Attends a one-hour, paid orientation on April 15, 2021
- Supports the educational and behavioral needs of students with autism in school settings
- Assists in the development of materials including visual schedules and activities
- Assists in modifying and/or designing and implementing adaptations within the school settings
- Assists with observations and data collection of students with mild to severe behavioral issues
- Assists in record keeping and implementation of computer software programs
- Communicates with ESY staff about student progress
- Is trained in Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (NCI) and strategies to support students' positive learning.
- Only one person will be hired for this itinerant position

**Schedule and Rate of Pay:**

- The Paraprofessional hired for this position is required to attend the planning day at a site/sites on Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup>.
- The program will run from Monday, June 7 through Friday, July 2, 2021 @ \$19.69 per hour
- Workdays will be Monday through Friday, 4.5 hours a day
