

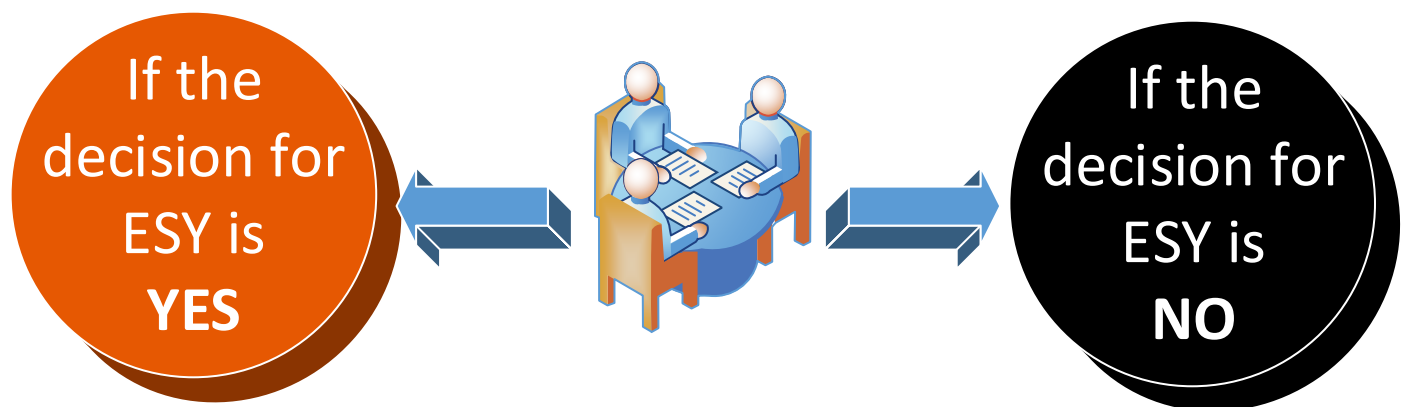
Talking to Parents about ESY

ESY Determination

A student's need for ESY is determined by the team at an IEP meeting.

The need for ESY is determined by Regression and Recoupment Data and/or Predictive Factors.

Speech Language Pathologists and OT/PT Service Providers collect data to qualify students for ESY speech and motor services. A student may not qualify for these services during ESY.



Students will be placed at ESY sites based on their home zip code.

Transportation will be arranged for students if a 1066 is filled out in a timely manner. 1066's submitted after the April 12, 2019 deadline may result in a bus stop that is further from the home.

ESY will be in the morning from June 10 – July 3, 2019.

You, as the teacher will inform the parents of ESY acceptance and ESY site.

The ESY office and ESY teachers will communicate additional information to the parents between Spring Break and the end of the school year.
